'Illegal structures on railway land halting major projects'

Activists blame authorities; WR says it has razed bamboo structures; has provision for rehabilitation of slum-dwellers as per law

Activists and railway commuters' association are completely supportive of the Western Railway's (WR) action against encroachment by slums outside Bandra station. They alleged that several railway projects are being put in cold storage owing to encroachment on railway land.

On Feb 7, WR and the Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) started removal of encroachments outside the station but was halted after the Bombay High Court stayed the process.

Chairman of Railway Pravasi Sangh, Nand Kumar Deshmukh said, "All encroachments on railway land should be removed. Many development projects are on hold because of innumerable encroachments. For instance, the Kalwa-Airoli elevated line and laying of the fifth and sixth lines from Kalyan to CSMT are also not progressing because of such structures."

Deshmukh said that the government makes stringent laws so that no government agency or the courts stay encroachment removal. "I also

RTI activist Anil Galgali said, "It's the railways' mistake, and there is a Government Resolution (GR) for rehabilitating these slums. The railways, BMC and other authorities concerned should visit the sites and rehabilitate the eligible dwellers as per

law."

Marine Lines south FOB to shut from Feb 15

The Marine Lines south-side foot overbridge (FOB) will be shut for nearly nine months from Feb 15 to Nov 30. The Western Railway at this time will undertake its dismantling and reconstruction. The FOB connects platform numbers 2/3 and 4 at the south side and is also directly connected to Marine Lines railway overbridge (ROB) from where passengers enter the station.

WR officials said the FOB is being rebuilt as it has completed its codal life. As per railway information, the interchange between platforms 4 and 2/3 or vice-versa will happen through the other two FOBs - middle and north - at Marine Lines station. For passengers entering from Marine Lines ROB, an opening will be provided at the booking office at platform number 1; else, passengers can use the staircase from ROB near platform number 4.

Lokhandwala-Vikhroli Metro Line 66% ready but depot is missing

While the 15.31km Swami Samarth Nagar (Lokhandwala Complex) to Vikhroli Metro Line 6 is 66% complete, the much needed car depot to operationalise the route is nowhere in sight.

This link is the second such mass rapid transit system connecting the suburbs; the earlier popular line being Mumbai Metro 1 connecting Versova with Ghatkopar. On Monday, the Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) shared an update on the line under construction. Breaking up each of the components of the project, the civil work on 13 stations connecting the eastern and western suburbs is 51.50% complete and the viaduct is 71% ready.

This route passes on Jogeshwari Vikhroli Link Road and is a double decker structure, which means the lower deck is an elevated road/ flyover and the upper portion is the Metro viaduct (an elevated civil structure that carries a rail line).

The 2.58km elevated vehicular road section of the engineering structure will provide signal free connection between the Western Express Highway and Eastern Express Highway. Whereas the Metro line will ferry commuters to work and back home.

This link will be integrated with four other routes, namely Mumbai Metro Lines 2A (Dahisar East to DN Nagar), 3 (Colaba-Bandra-SEEPZ), 4

(Wadala- Ghatkopar-Thane-Kasarvadavi-Gaimukh) and 7 (Dahisar East to Gundavali).

Additionally, Jogeshwari and Kanjurmarg railway stations will be linked with Mumbai Metro 1 in the same manner as Andheri and Ghatkopar railway stations.

However, the major hurdle in the project is the availability of land to establish a car depot. The MMRDA had planned for a depot at Kanjurmarg, but it is mired in a controversy and successive governments have been unable to resolve the issue. A few months back, the State Gov-

ernment had approached the Centre to hand over part ownership of the land, but has not been able to get a positive outcome so far.

Metropolitan Commissioner (MMRDA) SVR Srinivas said, "MMRDA is constructing the Metro network to provide mass rapid transit services to people within a short travel distance. Metro Line 6 will provide the much-needed rail-based connectivity between the western and eastern suburbs and will contribute to an integrated public transport network for Mumbai."

Want housing society rules on fingertips?

Housing societies office-bearers often struggle with rules pertaining to managing the society. To ease the search, the Navi Mumbai Cooperative Housing Federation, Maharashtra State Co-operative Housing Federation and a government official have designed a mobile application that is free of cost.

The idea to put together such a platform germinated during one of the

meetings in Mantralaya. Called Housing Co-op Master', it got the contribution of the government through Rajesh Lavekar, the Deputy Registrar of Cooperatives Societies, thereby ensuring veracity and updated content on the mobile platform.

Bhaskar Mhatre, the General Secretary of the Navi Mumbai Co-operative Housing Federation, said, "We have incorporated over 30 topics related to managing a housing society. There are plenty of managing com-

mittees and society members who don't have knowledge of rules, by-laws, circulars, etc. Hence, the idea had to be acted upon."

This mobile app is useful for all stakeholders, right from society members, managing committees to government officials.

Advocate Shreeraj Parab, expert director of the Maharashtra State Co-operative Housing Federation, said, "This is our attempt to provide all possible information with re-

gards to co-operative housing societies on a consolidated, single platform. The chapters have been made easy to understand by making smaller capsules of circulars, court rulings, judgements, laws, bye-laws and government regulations."

Though the app has been put together with topics concerning several day-to-day activities, Mhatre said they will continue to update it with more content, related circulars and topics as and when they are issued.

Metro 2A, 7 hours extended

The Maha Mumbai Metro Operation Corporation Limited (MMMOCL) has decided to extend the operating hours of the recently inaugurated Metro 2A and Metro 7 lines from Tuesday (Feb 14) for the next two months on a

pilot basis.

Instead of the last train leaving at 10.09pm, two additional services will be introduced on both lines to extend operating hours till 10.30pm, said MMOCL, the government agency operating and maintaining the two lines. If the new timings become popular among commuters, the

authorities may decide to continue in future.

MMMOCL Chairman SVR Srinivas said, "At present, we have 28 metro rakes that are sufficient to operate on both lines. We will continue to observe commuter response, and take a call to increase services during peak hours, if required."

Knowledge sharing between the state's police force on terrorism, naxalism and corruption will give better opportunities to deal with these problems, said urban development minister Bhupendra Singh Thakur, in the opening ceremony of 66th All India Police Duty Meet (AIPDM), here on Monday. The meet will conclude on Friday.

The minister further added that in comparison to last year, crime rate in the state has dropped to 19 per cent. He also said, "The state government is continuously helping the police personnel problems



and also of their families. We want that the police should be equipped with modern gadgets and should be able to control the criminal no matter how skilled he is technically sound".

"The well known dog breed deputed in White House America security, Belgian Malinois dog, soon will be the part of the MP police, they are capable of finding out the evidence which are buried under

two feet in the ground," the minister said. He claimed the anti sabotage check, computer awareness, dog competition, scientific aids, police photography and police videographer events will

enhance the capability of the police force.

DGP Sudhir Saxena said that the meet is being held for the third time in the state. He also added that the competitions which are being held in the meet, are related to the daily policing of the forces. "In the meet 100 dogs and police personnel from Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, BASF, Chhattisgarh, CRPF, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, ITBP, Jammu and Kashmir, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Punjab, Rajasthan, RPF, SSB, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, UP, Uttarakhand, West Bengal and Madhya Pradesh are participating," the DGP said.

Congress leader Saxena hits out at BJP over cancellation of trains ahead of Mahashivratri

Unidentified man booked for siphoning off Rs 60k from youth's account

The Nishatpura police station staff have registered a case of fraud against an unidentified person for siphoning off Rs 60,000 from a youth's account, the police said on Monday.

Station house officer of Nishatpura police station Rupesh Dubey said that the complainant, Shivam Namdeo, lived in a rented accommodation in Nishatpura area of the city and was preparing for competitive examinations. He added that Namdeo had applied for activation of online transaction facility on his credit card six months ago, but was unable to follow the process properly.

On February 4, Namdeo received a call from an unknown number and the person on the other side of the phone identified himself as a bank employee. The bank employee told him to download an app through a link which he sent him on a messaging application and said that his problem would be resolved after downloading the application.

Namdeo entered banking details soon after which, Rs 60,000 were deducted from his account and the call was disconnected. When Namdeo tried reaching out to the person who had called him, the number was switched off. Realising that he had been duped, Namdeo approached police and lodged a complaint against the man.

No complaint, no probe says EOW on minister Rajput receiving land as gift

The Economic Offences Wing (EOW) has declined to start inquiry into the alleged gift of agricultural land to Revenue Minister Govind Singh Rajput. The EOW officials said they haven't received complaint about it and therefore, they cannot initiate an inquiry.

The special court, in an order dated February 2, had sought status report from police station concerned following a private complaint moved under Section 200 of Cr.Pc.

The complainant Chandramohan Dubey claimed that the minister and others had caused a huge loss to the state exchequer by evading stamp duty and were thus guilty of committing a crime under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the IPC. The next hearing is on February 17.
