'Climate crisis is bomb ticking by sec'

Climate change is a bomb ticking by the second and no bunker would save humanity if collective efforts are not taken to find a solution to this existential problem, Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar said on Friday. Addressing the valedictory session of the 4th International Climate Summit organised by PHD Chamber of Commerce and Industry here, Dhankhar said fighting climate crisis should be everyone's foremost priority.

Goods train derails in Guj

A wagon of a goods train derailed between Valsad and Surat stations in Gujarat on Friday afternoon but there were no reports of anyone getting injured, a Western Railway (WR) official said. The train was 're-railed' at 5.39 pm, more than two hours after the derailment at 3.05 pm, and the traffic on DOWN main line will resume as soon as it receives a track fit certificate.

Mild quake hits Manipur

A mild earthquake, measuring 3.3 on the Richter scale, was felt in parts of Manipur and adjoining Nagaland on Friday, officials said. A disaster management official of Manipur said that the tremor was felt in northern Manipur's Ukhrul district and adjoining Nagaland. The district shares border with Myanmar.

Delhi Police busts kidney racket, arrests eight

An inter-state kidney transplant racket has been busted with the arrest of eight people, including its kingpin, following a week-long operation to crackdown on their activities in several places, including in Delhi-NCR, police said on Friday.

Besides them, seven others, including donors and recipients, have been "bound down" -- a legal process in which a person is required to appear at a certain date before authorities like a case's investigating officer or a court. Those arrested were part of a gang that used to get transplants done based on forged documents in multiple hospitals in Delhi-NCR, Punjab, Haryana, Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat, police said. The kidney donors were people from lower-income groups and they made the donation in lieu of money, Deputy Commissioner of Police (Crime) Amit Goel said. He added that the accused forged documents to show the donors as a close relative of the recipient, one of the mandatory provisions for organ donation and transplant.

Firm linked to Khedkar's mom sealed

The Pimpri-Chinchwad Municipal Corporation (PCMC) in Pune district sealed the defunct firm -- Thermoverita India Pvt Ltd -- located in the Talawade area over unpaid property dues. Notably, Puja Khedkar, while applying for a disability certificate at the Yashwantrao Chavan Memorial Hospital (YCM) in the Pimpri-Chinchwad township for selection into civil services under quota, had given the engineering firm's location as her residential address.

The junior bureaucrat's mother, Manorama Khedkar, is currently in the custody of Pune police in a criminal case.

KANWAR YATRA | UP gov't directive divides on basis of caste, religion, displays poor understanding of Lord Shiva: Vadra
'Crime against statute'Gaurav Vivek Bhatnagar
NEW DELHI

Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi Vadra on Friday criticised the directive from the Uttar Pradesh government to all the cart, kiosk and shopowners to display their names as "divisive" and claimed it was a crime against the Constitution.

The order was issued to establishments along the kanwar yatra route by the state administration so the kanwaris could know the caste and religion of the people they were making their purchases from. Lashing out at the state government for issuing such a "divisive order", Vadra wrote on X, "Our Constitution guarantees every citizen that he will not be discriminated against on the basis of caste, religion, language or any other basis. The divisive order to put up name boards of the owners of carts, kiosks and shops in Uttar Pradesh is an attack on our Constitu-

tion, our democracy and our shared heritage."

She added, "Creating division in society on the basis of caste and religion is a crime against the Constitution."

Meanwhile, Congress criticised the move for promoting identity politics and for polarising the masses. It added it was aimed at diverting the attention of people from issues like price rise, unemployment and distress among farmers.

Party national spokesperson Supriya Shrinete said people had rejected the negative politics of BJP during the recent Lok Sabha poll

but it has not learnt lessons.

"People rejected their negative politics and their Lok Sabha seats were reduced by 63. Even their allies like RLD and JDU are demanding a rollback of the order," she said. Shrinete added BJP only wants to "play divisive politics". On X, she said, "A poor street vendor is ordered to put up a plaque with his name on it, so Kanwaris do not buy anything from Muslim fruit sellers, do not eat at a Muslim hotel. It is BJP's habit to add a spice of hatred when they are unable to understand anything."

She added it is "irony is being done for Kanwaris who will go to collect the water to be offered on Shiv-ratri" and asked, "when will these vulgar and hypocritical self-proclaimed religious contractors understand Lord Shiv and his greatness".

Shrinete added, "The administration boycotts the poor, and the cowardly government spread such hatred only to hide its failures."

Admin cleared confusion, mustn't be turned into communal issue: Naqvi

BJP leader Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi claimed the Yogi government has cleared the "confusion" and said it has now given a guideline from the sanctity of the pilgrimage.

"The state government has corrected the confusion arising from a guideline of the local administration and has issued guidelines for everyone for the safety, respect and reverence of Kanwar Yatra and pilgrims," he said.

Govt lists 6 new bills for Parl monsoon sessionPTI

The Centre has listed six new bills for introduction, including the one which seeks to replace the 90-year-old Aircraft Act, to provide enabling provisions for ease of doing business in the aviation sector, in the upcoming Parliament session beginning Monday.

Besides the Finance Bill, the government has also listed 'The Disaster Management (Amendment) Bill' for introduction, consideration and passing.

The proposed legislation aims to bring more clarity and convergence in the roles of different organisations working in the field of disaster management, a Lok Sabha bulletin issued Thursday said.

The Bhartiya Vayuyan Vidheyak, 2024 seeks to replace the Aircraft Act of 1934 to provide enabling provisions for ease of doing business in the civil aviation sector.

The session beginning July 22 will conclude on August 12.

Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla has also constituted the Business Advisory Committee (BAC), which decides the parliamentary agenda.

NEET-UG

Paper solved in 45 mins before exam: Supreme Court to CentreOnline Report
NEW DELHI

The Supreme Court on Thursday heard a clutch of petitions seeking recall or cancellation of the 2024 NEET-UG - for entrance to undergraduate medical courses - and raised concerns over the stand of the Centre and the National Testing Agency (NTA) that the paper leak happened only about 45 minutes before the start of the exam in certain centres.

The results of the 2024 NEET-UG exam, which was held on May 5 have been plagued by allegations of leaked question papers and incorrectly awarded 'grace marks'.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta,

who represented the NTA, submitted that as per the CBI investigation, at a particular centre in Jharkhand's Hazaribagh, a person unauthorisedly took photographs of the question papers between 8 AM and 9.20 AM on the day of the exam.

A bench headed by Chief Justice DY Chandrachud wondered if all the 180 questions could have been solved within 45 minutes, given that the examination started at 10.15 AM, to which Mehta replied that there were seven persons in the gang who divided the questions among themselves. "Whole hypothesis that within 45 minutes there was a breach and the entire paper was solved and given to students seems very far-fetched," CJ said.

**'IS THIS A FASHION PARADE?'**

CJI slams lawyer for showing up without neckband

Chief Justice of India DY Chandrachud on Friday gave a dressing down to a lawyer for turning up in the courtroom without his band.

Neckbands are a part of lawyers' attire, along with their black coats.

The advocate raised a

matter related to a demolition case and said it was "urgent".

The Chief Justice of India, however, was unimpressed by his attire.

"Send an email. But where is your band? Is this some fashion parade going on?" he asked, Bar and Bench reported. When the advocate said he was "in a rush", the Chief Justice replied sternly.

Will probe all scams by BJP govts: SiddaRajashchakra S

Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah on Friday said that his government will order a probe into all scams that took place during the previous BJP government.

During his continued reply in the Assembly on Friday, on the Rs187.33 crore fund embezzlement in the Karnataka Maharishi Valmiki Scheduled Tribe Development Corporation, which led to the arrest of top officials and former ST welfare minister B Nagendra, the CM read out a list of alleged scams during the previous BJP government involving then CMs BS Yediyurappa, Basavaraj Bommai and their cabinet colleagues.

According to the scams listed out by Siddaramaiah, Agriculture Produce and Market Committee (APMC) scam worth Rs47.16 crore, Bhovi Development Corporation (Rs 87 crore), Devraj Urs Truck Terminal (Rs50 crore), over Rs430 crore in Ganga Kalyana (free sinking borewells for SC farmers), Rs247 crore in Karnataka State Tourism Devel-



opment Corporation and over Rs500 crore scam in Karnataka State Electronics Development Corporation (Keonics).

Amid din and uproarious scenes created by the Opposition members who trooped into the well, the CM said he would order a probe into the alleged irregularities in police sub inspector and police constables recruitment. He referred to Rs750 crore money and property papers found in the house of Umesh, one of the Yediyurappa's close associates.

He blamed the I-T and ED for being inactive by not questioning the Union Bank of India officials over large sums of money transfer during the Lok Sabha election and blamed Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman for her failure to check the 'corruption' and irregularities.

Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma on Friday claimed that Leader of Opposition (LoP) in Lok Sabha, Rahul Gandhi, should be made the brand ambassador for population control in the country as a particular community only listens to leaders of the Congress party.

CM Sarma further asserted that Assam will become a Muslim majority state by 2041.

Addressing the press here, CM Sarma claimed, "Anybody can travel to a Muslim-dominated village and ask the people which leader's advice they would like to listen to and the answer would be Rahul Gandhi. They will not listen to advice given by Himanta Biswa Sarma."

"That is why I feel that the Congress party must take some extra steps for population control in the country," he added.

The BJP leader also said that looking at the census figures for the last few decades in Assam, the state has witnessed a huge surge in Muslim population every 10 years.

K'taka Lokayukta raids 55 locationsIANS
BENGALURU

The Karnataka Lokayukta conducted raids at 55 locations, including residences, offices, and other properties of about 12 officials on Friday across the state in connection with Disproportionate Assets.

According to sources, Lokayukta raids are underway at six locations in Bengaluru city, two in Bengaluru Rural District, two in Shivamogga, and one each in Yadagiri and Tumakuru.

At least seven properties of the Karnataka Industrial Areas Development Board's (KIADB) Director in Bena-

luru's Nagarabhhavi area, his house in Banashankari in Bengaluru, and his farmhouses in Chikkannayakanahalli and Ranganaathapura in Tumakuru have been searched. The Bengaluru residence and properties of a municipality Commissioner, Joint Commissioner of the Commercial Tax Department, and residences of the gram panchayat presidents in Bengaluru Rural, Shivamogga and Yadgiri districts have been raided.

What is this plea: SC Junks Bilkis Bano convicts' bail pleasPTI
NEW DELHI

The Supreme Court on Friday refused to entertain a plea of two of the 11 convicts in the Bilkis Bano case challenging the January 8 verdict cancelling their remission.

A bench of Justices Sanjiv Khanna and Sanjay Kumar termed the plea as "absolutely misconceived" and said how can it sit in appeal over an order passed by another

bench of the apex court. "What is this plea? How is this plea maintainable? This is absolutely misconceived. How can an Article 32 petition be filed? We can't sit in appeal

over an order passed by another bench," the bench said. Advocate Rishi Malhotra appearing for convicts Bhagwandas Shah and Soni sought permission to withdraw plea.

Delhi Police busts kidney racket, arrests eight

An inter-state kidney transplant racket has been busted with the arrest of eight people, including its kingpin, following a week-long operation to crackdown on their activities in several places, including in Delhi-NCR, police said on Friday.

Besides them, seven others, including donors and recipients, have been "bound down" -- a legal process in which a person is required to appear at a certain date before authorities like a case's investigating officer or a court.

Those arrested were part of a gang that used to get transplants done based on forged documents in multiple hospitals in Delhi-NCR, Punjab, Haryana, Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat, police said.

The kidney donors were people from lower-income groups and they made the donation in lieu of money, Deputy Commissioner of Police (Crime) Amit Goel said. He added that the accused forged documents to show the donors as a close relative of the recipient, one of the mandatory provisions for organ donation and transplant.

Firm linked to Khedkar's mom sealed

U'khand High Court grants protection to inter-faith live-in couple

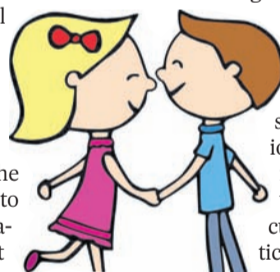

Paper solved in 45 mins before exam: Supreme Court to Centre

Online Report NEW DELHI

The Supreme Court on Thursday heard a clutch of petitions seeking retest or cancellation of the 2024 NEET-UG - for entrance to undergraduate medical courses - and raised concerns over the stand of the Centre and the National Testing Agency (NTA) that the paper leak happened only about 45 minutes before the start of the exam in certain centres.

The results of the 2024 NEET-UG exam, which was held on May 5 have been plagued by allegations of leaked question papers and incorrectly awarded 'grace marks'.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta,

who represented the NTA, submitted that as per the CBI investigation, at a particular centre in Jharkhand's Hazaribagh, a person unauthorisedly took photographs of the question papers between 8 AM and 9.20 AM on the day of the exam.

A bench headed by Chief Justice DY Chandrachud wondered if all the 180 questions could have been solved within 45 minutes, given that the examination started at 10.15 AM, to which Mehta replied that there were seven persons in the gang who divided the questions among themselves. "Whole hypothesis that within 45 minutes there was a breach and the entire paper was solved and given to students seems very far-fetched," CJI said.



K'taka Lokayukta raids 55 locations

Members may kindly note that SEBI vide its Circular No. SEBI/HO/MIRSD/POD-1/PICIR/2023/181 dated November 17, 2023, has done away with the provisions of (i) freezing of folios not having PAN, KYC, and Nomination details and (ii) referral of the frozen folios by the RTA / listed company to the administering authority under the Benami Transactions (Prohibitions) Act, 1988 and/or Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002.

4. Remote e-voting facility
Remote E-voting facility (remote e-voting) is provided to members to cast their vote on resolutions set out in the notice of AGM.
